

Parents' Guide to Remote Learning

Google Meet Expectations

- Students should wear appropriate clothing.
- Please show up to meetings on time, but do not log on more than 5 minutes before the start time.
- Students should stay muted until it is their turn to talk.
- Please avoid distracting behavior during meetings (eating, playing with toys, making funny faces, siblings entering the video).
- Students should not be using the chat room during live lessons, unless instructed by the teacher.

Suggestion: Your child can use headphones to decrease distractions.

Attendance

- We are still following Orrville Elementary/Middle School rules and guidelines.
- Students must be present and prompt for morning live meetings. Students who are not present will be marked as absent.
- If your child is sick or has an appointment, please call the school so it can be considered an **excused** absence.

School Work

- It is important that your child sticks to the daily schedule that is provided by the teacher on the Google Website.
- Teachers will provide a combination of live and recorded lessons.
- **We are more concerned with the learning process, rather than simply completing work for correct answers. Please refrain from working days ahead. Students will benefit from completing schoolwork after instruction has been given.**
- Please use Google Classroom to submit assignments. If you are uploading pictures, there is a tutorial on each teacher's website.
